Dear First Grade Parent,

We are looking forward to having your child in class this fall. Our school has a summer reading program to be done at home by the students. This program is designed to keep their skills abreast and to enhance their reading and writing capabilities. The requirements for a child entering first grade are as follows:

1. Read two books from any of the following series:

- “I Can Read” series

- “I’m Going to Read” series

- “Ready to Read” series

- “Step Into Reading” series

- “All Aboard Reading” series

- “I Can Read It All By Myself” series

These books are available at the local library and in book stores.

2. Read two Caldecott books. These are award winning books and available at the local library and in book stores.
3. Read a book of your choice.
4. A book report should be completed for each book that is read. The book reports will be due the first week of school. Each book report must contain the following information:
 - First and last name of the student
 - Book title
 - Author’s name
 - Write a sentence or two about the story
 - Draw and color a picture about the story
