All students will read a book from the Bible.

6th Grade: the **Book of Psalms** from the Old Testament 7th Grade: the **Gospel of John** from the New Testament 8th Grade: the **Acts of the Apostles** from the New Testament **A scripture quiz will be given upon return to school in the fall.**

IN ADDITION TO THE SCRIPTURE READING, all students from each grade will receive individual packets containing a novel, a short story, and an informational article. The envelope and its contents must be returned in the fall during the first week of school. All students' written assessments (quiz, test, synopsis, summary, etc.) for each piece of required reading will be completed in school during the first full week they are back in the classroom.

- 2. "To Build a Fire" by Jack London (Short Story)
- 3. "Iditarod Trail Sled Dog Race" by Susan H. Butcher (Article)

Assessments FOR ALL READING REQUIREMENTS must be completed upon students' return in the fall. Assessment will include:

- *NOVEL—<u>Handwritten</u> chapter notes MUST be completed during the summer and submitted in the fall; a short answer essay test will be administered.
- *SHORT STORY--identifying elements such as plot, conflict, characters, setting, theme:
- *ARTICLE--summarizing the article will be completed in class upon students' return in the fall.

EXCEPT FOR THE CHAPTER NOTES STUDENTS ARE TO COMPLETE AT HOME, ALL ASSESSMENTS WILL TAKE PLACE AFTER SCHOOL STARTS.
