Dear St. Patrick Religious Education Families,

We hope you are enjoying a restful start to what will hopefully be a rejuvenating summer! We are excited to share information about a new year of religious education activities in 2022 – 23!

The Catechism of the Catholic Church reminds us that the family and parents are the **PRIMARY** educators of the faith for their children. It is through *your* word and example that your children first come to know God and begin a personal relationship with Jesus Christ. When children are baptized, the Church community promises to help parents foster their faith. Our Faith Formation program is designed to assist and support you in this important duty.

For the 2022-2023 school year, St. Patrick Catholic Community Faith Formation Program will have two options for grades 1 – 7. Option 1: Sunday mornings from 9:30 A.M. – 10:45 A.M. Option 2: Wednesday evenings from 5:15 P.M. – 6:30 P.M. Classes will be held at St. Patrick School.

Eighth grade religious education is combined with Confirmation Preparation and will be offered on the Sunday morning schedule from 9:30 A.M. – 10:45 A.M. Class will be held in the library in Building #4.

Faith Formation classes will meet approximately three times a month from August 2022 – May 2023.

Our faith requires weekly attendance at Mass. We encourage families to attend Mass with their children on every Sunday and Holy Day of the year.

We ask you to encourage regular attendance and participation in Faith Formation classes, activities, and Sunday Mass. *Please see the Faith Formation Calendar and Sacramental preparation dates enclosed.*

The goals for our program are:

- ❖ To develop an understanding of the Catholic faith and practices in the lives of our families.
- ❖ To foster a personal relationship with Jesus Christ through prayer.
- ❖ To prepare students to receive the Sacraments of Reconciliation, Eucharist, and Confirmation.

The textbook we will be using is Faith and Life: A Catechetical Series by Ignatius Press. Textbooks and supplies are covered by the Faith Formation fees. **Please Note:** Tuition is \$125.00 per student up to \$225.00 per family. For children receiving the Sacrament of 1<sup>st</sup> Reconciliation, there will be an additional fee of \$20, 1<sup>st</sup> Communion - \$30, and Confirmation - \$40 in order to cover expenses. **Tuition and fees are due at the time of registration.**

Registrations can be turned into the Faith Formation Office (Parish Office) Monday through Thursday from 8:30 A.M. – 4:30 P.M. and Friday 8:30 - 12:00 PM. New registrations can also be found at our website at <https://www.stpatsparish.org/religious-education>. There will be a late fee of \$15 after August 10, 2022.

We look forward to seeing you and working with you as we join in guiding our children to know, love, and serve Our Lord. May God bless you and your family this coming year!

### WELCOME MASS

Our Catholic faith tells us that the Eucharist is the “source and summit of the Christian life,” meaning that all we do flows from and returns to our celebration of the Mass and the special encounter we share with Jesus in Holy Communion. ## SACRAMENTAL NOTES

In an attempt to foster the understanding of parents being the primary teachers of the faith to their children, our sacramental preparation for Reconciliation and Communion asks that **parents be present** during the formation days noted below. This will serve as an opportunity, in addition to attending Sunday Mass and praying together at home, to grow in faith as a family and illustrate that learning about Our Lord and His Church is a lifelong journey even their parents are continuing to pursue! Children eligible to receive First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion will receive an invitation and registration letter prior to preparation's start. If you are new to the parish, do not receive a letter regarding receiving the sacraments, or have any questions/concerns, please call the parish office.

## SACRAMENT OF CONFIRMATION

Unlike the sacraments of Reconciliation and Communion, the ordinary minister of the Sacrament of Confirmation is not a priest but a bishop. That being said, planning a date for Confirmation (and also the retreat to occur prior to it) will be dependent on Bishop McClory's schedule. Once the spring date is finalized, we will communicate that information to you. Thank you for your understanding!

# RCIA for Children

Rite to Christain Initiatian (RCIA) with children is suited for students who are older than second grade and have not yet received the sacraments of Baptism, Reconciliation or Holy Eucharist. Children and parents will participate in an RCIA process that will prepare them for their sacraments.

Candidate Children who have been baptized will be received into the Church, and receive their First Reconciliation in the winter of 2023, and their First Communion at Easter Vigil 2023. Catechumenate Children who are unbaptized will receive Baptism and First Eucharist at Easter Vigil 2023. Students will join the Religious Education Program at their grade level following the process and become prepared for the Sacrament of Confirmation. The parents of these students should contact the religious education office (219-926-1282) for more information. Fees for RCIA with Children is \$125 with a \$20 fee for 1<sup>st</sup> Reconciliation, and \$30 for 1<sup>st</sup> Eucharist to cover expenses.
