The summer reading requirement for students who will be entering first grade has two options as described below. You must choose <u>one</u> of the options and the summer math book to complete by the <u>end of the first week of the new school year.</u>

Option One

Each student will complete <u>two</u> book reports. Do not type your book reports. You may use any type of paper to write the reports. Please write two sentences about the book. Make sure that the sentences begin with a capital letter and end with a punctuation mark. <u>Draw and color</u> a picture to go with the story.

Read one book from any of the following series:

"I Can Read", "I'm Going to Read", "Ready to Read", "Step Into Reading", "All Aboard Reading" or "I Can Read It All By Myself". These books are available at the local library and in book stores.

Read one Caldecott books.

These are award winning books and are available at the local library and in book stores.

Option Two

Westchester Public Library summer reading program

If you attend their summer reading program and fully complete it, the library will send the school a list of students who have finished the program. They will send the list at the beginning of the year, so you will be able to receive your points.
