

2nd Grade Summer Reading

Choose either Option 1 or Option 2

Option 1 – You will complete 2 book reports. You may use any type of lined paper to write the reports.
(Do not type your book reports.)

1. Read 2 Caldecott Medal or Honor Books. A list of Caldecott books are available at the library.
2. A book report is to be completed for each of the 2 books.
3. Begin the title with a capital letter. Remember to capitalize all important words in a title.
4pts. (2pts. each)
4. Underline the title of the book. 2pts. (1pt. each)
5. Write the author's name using correct capitalization. 2pts. (1pt each)
7. Write 3 sentences stating what the book is about. 8pts. (4pts each)
8. Write 2 sentences telling why you liked the book. 4pts. (2pts each)

Option 2 - The Westchester Public Library offers a summer reading program. If you complete their summer reading program, the library will send the school a list of students who have completed the program. They will send the list at the beginning of the year, so you will be able to receive credit. You will need to contact the library for more information. If your child's name is not on the list they must have a completed certificate, worksheet, etc. to receive full credit. Students whose names are not on the list and do not have paper documentation will not receive credit for the program and will have to complete 2 book reports.
