

Kindergarten Supply List

- 1 Plastic Box (approx. 8"x5") - to keep supplies in
- 3 Large boxes of Tissues – for classroom
- 1 Box of zip top baggies – any size – for classroom
- 3 Containers of Wipes – for classroom
- 4* Glue sticks
- 1 Small Bottle of Glue
- 1* Box of Crayons – (*no more than 24 count*)
- 1 Pair of Scissors
- 5* #2 Pencils – sharpened
- 2* Erasers
- 1 Box of band-aids
- 1 Reusable gel ice pack

Please have your child's name on all of his/her supplies.

* indicates that these items will need to be replaced throughout the year – buy extras!

Please do not send markers, pencil sharpeners, or large boxes of crayons to school.

Snack - a nutritious snack for the morning and afternoon should be sent each day with your student. Some examples are: fruit, veggies, pretzels, granola bars, and crackers. Candy should not be brought for snack.

Gym – students will need to wear gym shoes to school on this day to participate.

Lunch –. Students bring a cold lunch from home. There is no hot lunch available.


All kindergarteners must wear a tag the first two weeks of school. It must say how your child is getting to and from school (bus, car, extended care). An example tag is shown below.

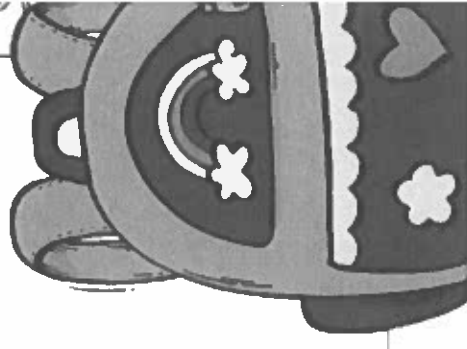

FIRST GRADE SUPPLIES

- 1 box of pre-sharpened #2 pencils
- 1 box of 24 crayons
- 3 plastic folders (red and green; one your choice for homework)
- 1 primary journal (dotted lines and space for pictures) → 
- 1 wide-ruled spiral notebook
- 1 pencil box
- 1 standard 12 in. plastic ruler (not bendable)
- 4 glue sticks
- 1 pair of scissors (blunt tip)
- 1 pack of 4 Expo dry erase markers
- 1 box of gallon sized ziploc bags
- 1 pair of headphones
- 1 ream of printer paper

*Some supplies will need to be replenished throughout the year. A note will be sent home when replacements are needed.



Second Grade Supply List

- Zippered pencil case or Pencil box 6"x8" max (with name on it)
- FISKAR Scissors (pointed, 3 inch or shorter)
- 4 BIG Boxes of Tissues
- 3 Glue sticks
- 20 #2 pencils (Already sharpened, please)
- 2 pencil erasers (plain pink erasers)
- Crayola Crayons (24-pack only)
- 8 Crayola Markers, (Broad line, Classic Colors)
- 4 EXPO dry erase markers - Black chisel tip
- 12" Ruler with inches and centimeters, & "ZERO mark" (no flexible rulers or poppet rulers, please)
- 12 Colored Pencils
- 5 Folders - one green, one red, one blue, one yellow, one of your choice
- Earbuds or headphones for Chromebooks - must have an Auxillary audio connector
- 1 box of ziplock bags gallon (girls) or quart (boys)
- 1 container of disposable anti-bacterial wipes (for surfaces, not hands)
- 1 ream of white printer paper
- *Optional 1 - Manual Pencil Sharpener (with container for shavings)

- 1 Reusable cold ice pack - this will be put in the freezer for future use

**When you are purchasing supplies at "back to school" sale prices, please consider buying extra and tucking them away. Often kids begin to lose all their crayons by December, and you can't find a \$0.50 box of crayons in December! Also, classroom donations are always welcome. I try to have pencils, markers, and crayons in class for students who need something during school.

Third Grade Supply List

In Third Grade, we have two sets of supplies: Personal Supplies and Community Supplies. Personal supplies are kept in each student's desk and may need to be replenished throughout the year. These include folders, notebooks, crayons, and other specific and personal items. Community supplies are gathered into one of our classroom cabinets and will be shared and distributed whenever needed. These include more general supplies that are used (and used up) frequently by all of our students, such as pencils, glue sticks, and tissues. Please mark personal items with your student's name. Please leave community supplies unlabeled since they will be shared by all.

Personal Supplies List:

(Labeled with name)

- Zippered Pencil Case - As thin and flat as possible. Desk space comes at a premium!
- 5 Folders – Feel free to label them in advance
 - Music
 - Science
 - Social Studies
 - Keep at School Folder
 - Homework Folder
- Scissors – small, pointed
- Crayons – A small/standard pack, 24 or smaller.
- Crayola Washable Markers
- Crayola Colored Pencils – Standard colors 12/pk
- Personal Pencils (already sharpened)
- 2 Erasers
- 1 Pack of Black Sharpie Markers
- 1 Pack of Dry Erase Markers (darker colors or black preferred)
- Transparent Ruler with inches, centimeters, quarter inch marks, and a zero mark
- 2 Spiral notebooks (wide rule) in different colors-no black please
 - One for math, one for reading. Plan to replace around midyear.
- Wired Earbuds/Headphones for Chromebooks – No Bluetooth
